- visit and stroll through traditional and modern Places of Worship with many images. The subject of each piece will be identified and the craftsmanship techniques will be discussed informally.
- learn more about the Art Glass Windows at the Children's Hospital, where many families seek comfort in the non-denominational Chapel

The instructor will highlight unique characteristics of Art Glass such as Modern Art, the use of Dalles de Verres, also known as Slab Glass. The artists' visions will be shared.



Janice Wilson, a local stained glass artist, has been involved with Glass Arts repairs for 20 years, serving as a Stained Glass Appraiser in good standing with the Canadian Personal Property Appraisers Group for the past 8 years, and from her studio, has produced commissioned work for the last 5 years.
